

The key points re qualification of the “Wagga” proceedings manuscripts as DIISR^(a) – HERDC^(b) E1 category conference publications are as follows:

^(a) Department of Innovation, Industry, Science and research

^(b) Higher Education Research Data Collection

In order for a conference publication to be counted in a university’s Research Publications Return, the paper must be:

- (i) published in full
- (ii) available beyond the realm of the conference participants (such as via open web access or CD/book of proceedings)
- (iii) peer reviewed as a full paper
This means assessment or review of the research publication in its entirety (not just the abstract) by qualified anonymous experts who are independent of the author (not just a panel).
- (iv) presented at a conference that can be demonstrated to be of national or international significance
